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It was felt that students should be afforded avenues for developing skills and knowledge that increases their employability and/or leads to their holistic development. The institute offers various professional courses by synergising with professional bodies, but it is also desirable that some certificate courses are designed inhouse and are made available to students free of charge or at very nominal charges. Certificate Courses Dr. Gidwani suggested that the institute should seek approval from Savitribai Phule Pune University to lend credibility to the courses. Decision: It was decided that faculty members would brainstorm and come up with different certificate courses, each of 30 hours and seek approval from SPPU. Teachers were requested to submit their proposals with proper learning outcomes and units for each certificate course. It was decided that a minimum of 3 courses would be designed. Due to the pandemic times, the construction and completion of the Badminton Court had been delayed. However, it is ready now and it was proposed that the asset paid for by the Parent Body, Sadhu Vaswani Mission, should be transferred to the institute. Badminton Court Decision: Dr. B H Nanwani was requested to request the management to kindly transfer the asset in the name of the institute so that it can be reflected in the Balance Sheet for the Financial Year 2021-22. SVIMS being a B-School, it is very necessary that students should be exposed to professionals in fields like Marketing, Finance, HR, etc. While all efforts are taken to invite industry experts to deliver lectures on contemporary issues. it is necessary for students to be part of professional groups and witness their seminars, deliberations and the manner in which they solve complex issues.
